

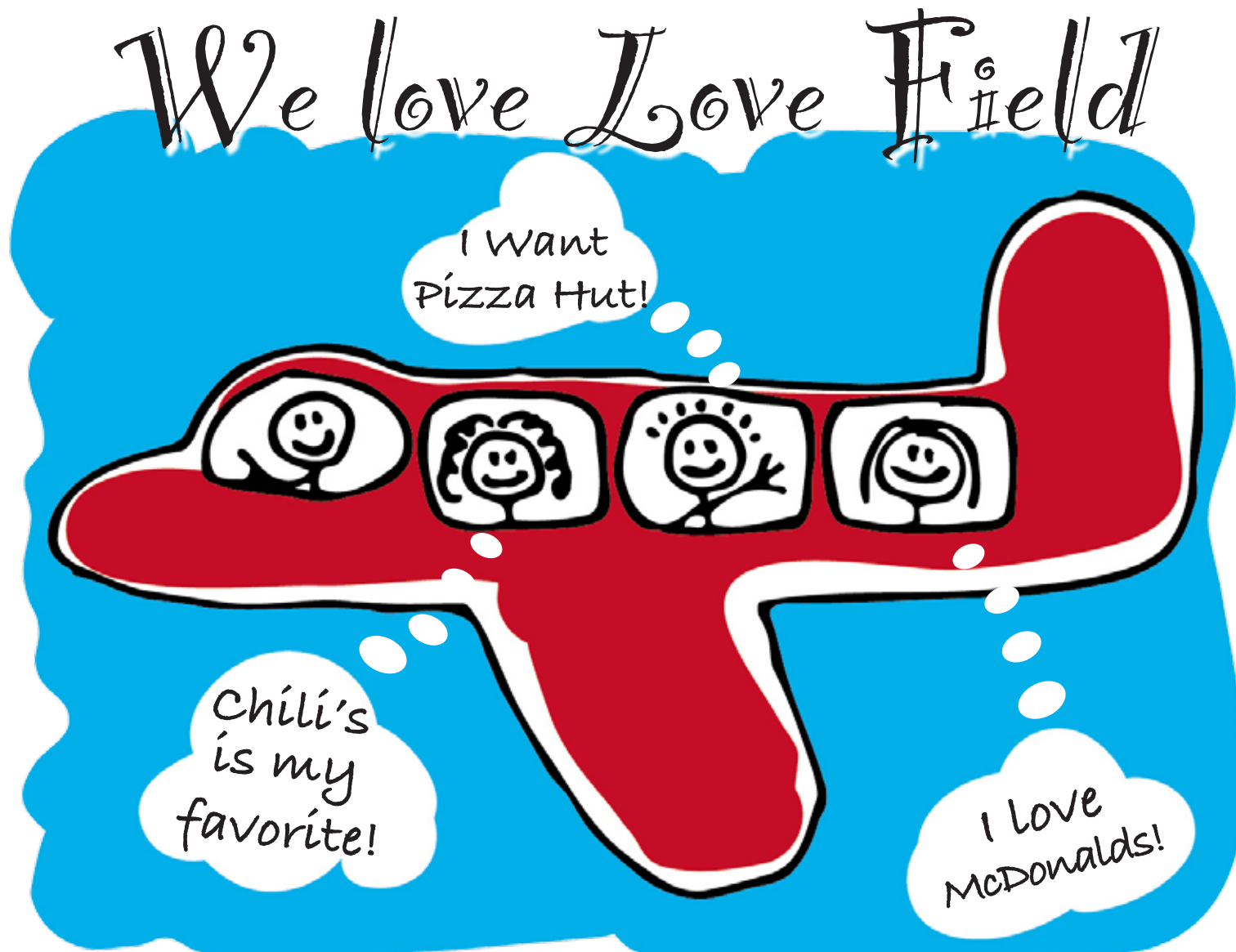

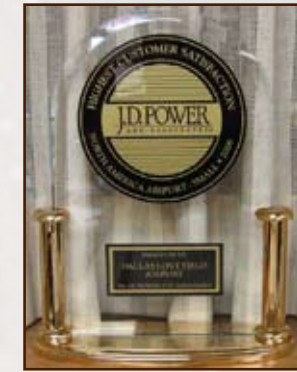


As quality, service and choices have increased, so have rents to the City of Dallas.
